We are an approved partner to the University of Johannesburg's Work Integrated Learning programme for the visual art and public relations academic programmes. Each year between 2 and 3 students are placed in the organization to complete their required work hours for the qualification of their diploma's.

Our interns have consistently achieved excellent results scoring among the top in their classes. Both present and past permanent and project staff have been drawn from this programme, with some moving from intern position to full time employment, and subsequent middle management. Between 2008 & 2013 seventeen UJ students have benefitted from their internships and training with the company.

Where possible we also advocate strongly for development opportunities, internships and learnerships to become a key part of our client's projects. This has afforded opportunities for hands on training in the industry. Students and aspirant arts administrators we have worked with on past projects include among others Anthea Moys who served as Assistant Curator to Les Cohn on the 2007 Sasol Wax Art Award and has gone on to with the inaugural Standard Bank Young Artist of the Year Award for Performance Art in 2013.
